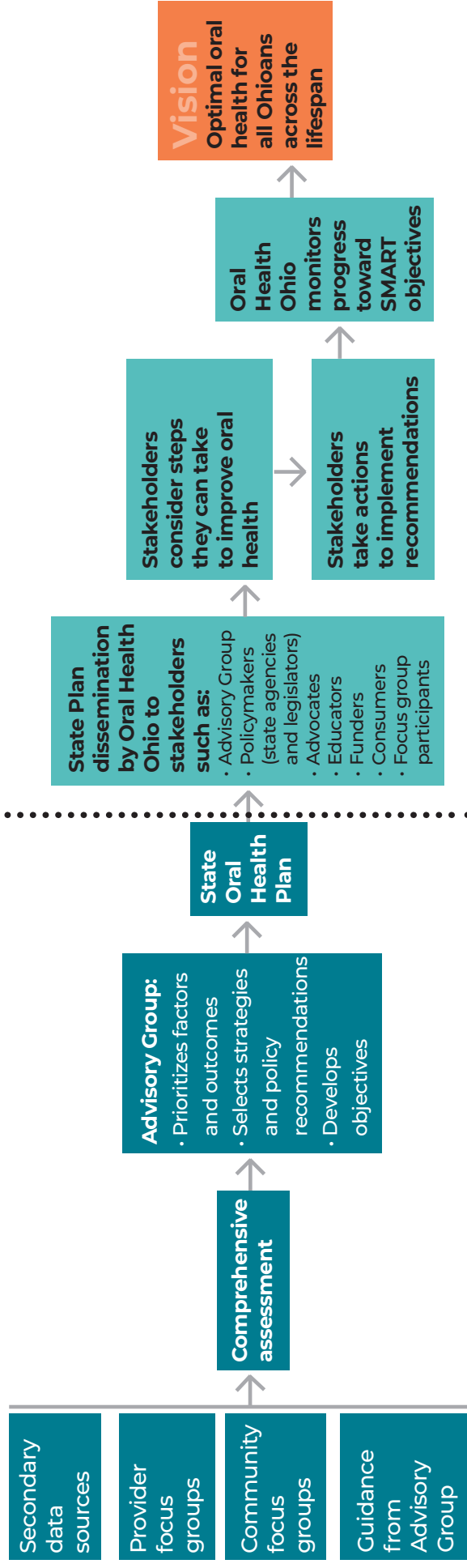
## Appendix B. State Oral Health Plan Pathway to Impact

The Ohio 2023-2027 State Oral Health Plan was produced through a collaborative effort of approximately 200 Ohioans (State Plan page 38). This State Oral Health Plan Pathway to Impact outlines the phases of developing the Plan and steps that can be taken by Oral Health Ohio and State Plan partners after its release to achieve the vision of optimal oral health for all Ohioans across the lifespan.

### Purpose

The Ohio State Oral Health Plan is an actionable roadmap to ensure oral health is integrated with, and elevated to, the same importance as overall health. The State Plan is designed to guide actions taken by policymakers, advocates, educators, providers, and funders.
